



Family Devotional Guide

This guide is designed to help your family have meaningful conversations at home. You can keep a copy of the script nearby (or download it) while you read this guide. The questions could be read out loud by kids or adults and answered by everyone in your family. It could be discussed all at once or one scene each day during the Christmas break. May you truly enjoy this Christmas.

Scene I – It’s Time To Work!

Grandfather Longpaws has some pretty big expectations for Jeremiah when he says, *“This isn’t a time to eat cheese bonbons, it’s time to work!”* And Jeremiah doesn’t want to let his grandfather down.

What kind of expectations do you have at home, school, work or for Christmas?

Are you happy with these expectations?

The expectations around us can often be overwhelming, stressful, and cause us to be filled with. What does 1 Peter 5:7 say about our stress and anxiety?

“But those who hope in the Lord will renew their strength. They will soar with wings like eagles” Isaiah 40:31



Scene II – Looking for Something

What would you like for Christmas that would be glorious?

It can be easy to forget some of the glorious blessings we already have. What are you thankful for?

There were a couple of true stories that Jeremiah put on page 2, 3, and 4 of his newspaper, what were they?

What does Proverbs 19:21 tell us about our plans?

Why do our plans fail sometimes?

Sometimes we try to find happiness and joy in life with our toys, gadgets, and trips, but the excitement wears off. Have you ever felt bored with your toys, devices or vacations?

Jeremiah and Benny go on a journey to find something at Bon Bolt’s Laboratory. In the history of the Nativity (Luke 2), which people go on a special journey? What do they find?

Scene III – They don't look very glorious

Bon Bolt says the phrase “the Spirit at Christmas.” What do you think that means?

Read Galatians 5:22-24. How can you live out the Spirit at Christmas?

Read John 14:16. What does this verse tell us about how God helps us?

What does Acts 1:8 tell us about living life with the Holy Spirit? What does he help us do?

Scene IV – Have a faith

Jeremiah and Benny end up on a glorious adventure as they travelled through time to see Jesus. But they are still cautious and allow the evidence to guide them to the Savior.

Sometimes the best gifts don't come with a nice red bow. God loves people so much that he sent his Son to be the Savior of the world.
